A Lesson on Flash Floods

In our 5/6 class we are lucky enough to have a student teacher from the University of Newcastle called Pak James. We have all enjoyed having Pak James as a teacher. He does very creative lessons and they involve natural disasters such as drought and floods. He did an amazing lesson about floods on Thursday. He split us into groups of four, half of us got things to reinforce the river the other half got nothing to protect their part. We dug an even moat that we called our "river" in our school sandpit. The groups that got to reinforce their river put rocks, sticks, bark and leaves in their part. For the other groups that got nothing to reinforce their river only got to pat down the edges of the sand, but these people were allowed rocks, sticks, bark and leaves on the edges of the river. Then Pak James got us to write a hypothecs of what we thought might happen. To simulate the flood we poured buckets of water down the river lots of rocks, sticks, bark and leaves rushed with force down the river. All the sides eroded away leaving a wider river, all the water banked up at the bottom of the river. This showed us what really happens to many lives, and as the reinforced parts washed away we realized that could be cars, houses and sometimes even people. Pak James brought us back into class to record our results on flood. Now we have witnessed what happens and can relate it to what happens when we get floods in the Nambucca Valley.
