Indonesian Language Learning Ambassador



Last week we hosted Chatarina Behar from Kupang, West Timor as our school's Indonesian Language Learning Ambassador. This is a program run by the Asia Education Foundation, aimed at promoting the study of Indonesian in schools by sending Indonesian recipients of Australian Awards scholarships into schools to share Indonesian language and culture as well as their area of study with Australian school students.

Chatarina is a science lecturer at a Nusa Cendana University in Kupang, who is currently undertaking postgraduate study at the University of New England in Armidale Chatarina shared some renewable energy and sustainable practices with our students, constructing self watering plant pots with Year 12, and making "Biopore" underground compost with Year 5/6. She also shared a contemporary eastern Indonesian line dance (in the style of the Nutbush), called "Kaka Enda" with Years 5/6, 4/5, 1/2 and Kinder/1.


